#### **Next Board Meeting**

The next Board of Directors meeting is scheduled to follow the conclusion of the Annual Meeting of the Members on Tuesday, March 10, 2009, in the clubhouse. The agenda for the meeting will be posted adjacent to the clubhouse doors 4 days prior to the meeting. Please note that the master and earthquake insurance coverage renews on March 23, 2009. It may be necessary for the Board to borrow some funds from the reserve account to help cover the premium invoice. The operating fund will pay the loan back to the reserves prior to the end of the fiscal year on December 31, 2009.

Landscape Committee Message

The Landscape Committee will now meet on the third Wednesday of the month. Our next meeting will be March 18 at 7:00 pm in the Clubhouse. Please submit any landscaping requests, in writing, for the committee's consideration. Please remember that the Board of Directors provides a budget to the Committee, which determines the guidelines the Committee must adhere to in planning for landscaping maintenance and upgrade projects. In other words, the Committee will accommodate as many requests as possible, as long as they fit within budget constraints, as well as short-term and long-term landscaping plans.

You will notice some changes in our complex. The upgrade work on Huxley has begun and should be completed mid February. Once this is completed, the upgrade work will begin on Donovan and Foxhall. Goals have been to remove many older, overgrown plantings, the ivy and jasmine and the smaller grassy areas, replacing with drought-tolerant or low-water plantings. We hope you will like the changes.

You will also notice that the very large escalonia hedges have been "hard pruned." This is necessary to keep them from encroaching on sidewalk and other walking areas. For now, this results in a hedge with bare branches and very few leaves, but we are hopeful that the spring and warm weather will bring new growth that will greatly improve their look.

#### **Board of Directors Elections**

The secret ballots submitted for the Board elections will be counted by the election inspectors during the Board meeting that will follow the conclusion of the annual meeting. If you have not mailed in your secret ballot, please remember that they must be received by no later than 6:45PM on March 10, 2009.

## **Exterior Changes To Your Unit**

Please remember that the governing documents for 1600 Hamilton REQUIRE that ALL changes to the exterior appearance of your unit MUST have PRIOR approval from the Board of Directors. This means that ANYTIME you want to change an exterior light fixture, a screen door, or even change the design of your entry or patio areas, you must first provide a written request for approval to the Board describing, in detail, the proposed changes. Failure to do so may result in the Board requiring that you change the modification, at your expense. The reason for this rule is to help protect the overall appearance of the complex and prevent an owner from installing something that might result in higher association maintenance expenses or lower real estate values.

Note: The CC&Rs stipulate that all doors and windows are the maintenance responsibility of the unit owners. Please make sure you have approval from the Architectural Committee prior to installing new windows or doors.

PLEASE DO NOT leave any water or food outside and if you know someone who is doing this, please contact association manager Bill Hubbard so that the association can take the necessary disciplinary action so that the activity stops.

## **Gutter Cleaning**

Bright Outlook has completed the gutter and downspout cleaning. The cleaning carries a "no clog" warranty until May 1, 2009. If you see that your downspout has become CLOGGED <u>after</u> the initial cleaning, please contact the CMS customer service dept during normal business hours and they will arrange for Bright Outlook to address the problem within 2 business days, weather permitting.
