ITEM I - Order

President Heath Birkendahl called the Annual Meeting of the Membership to order at 6:30PM.

ITEM II - Introduction

The Board and management introduced themselves to the membership.

ITEM III - President's and Committee Reports

Heath Birkendahl reviewed the major projects and expenses for 2018 and tentative projects for 2019:

2018 projects - Reserve expenses

Termite control: \$4,250

Plumbing repairs (outdoor, interior, and repairs resulting from interior plumbing leaks): \$42,198

Landscaping replacements/enhancements: \$39.550

Tree removals and replacements \$18,812 Irrigation repairs/upgrades/valves: \$43,480

Cement walkway repairs: \$16,061

Complete the walkway LED bollard lighting project: \$188,253 spent in 2018, \$75,945 spent in 2018

Entry monument signs: \$16,920 General Operating Expenses:

Annual roofs, gutters, and downspouts cleaning: \$14,447

General landscape maintenance: \$115,008

Water: \$239,663

Large Tree care: \$35,400

Pest control: \$7,500

Management: \$85,800

Blanket and earthquake insurance: \$127,204

Tentative 2019 capital improvement projects

Exterior garage building lighting: \$36,999

Repairs and maintenance to all asphalt streets and curbs:

ITEM IV - Counting of ballots and announcement of voting results
