I. Open Forum

II. Call to Order

III. Ongoing Work

A. Walk About

- Hard pruning will continue this month with the pittisporum and photinia.
- Reviewed bids for upgrades on Greenwich including traffic island at 1367 Greenwich, where overgrown photinias impede vision.

B. Review of Recent New Work

- Recent work included hard pruning of abelias, photinia and some pittisporum. Work will continue this month to complete hard pruning.
- Hamilton Place entrance on Greenwich side is completed Medallion will add two rows of stepping stones at the middle of the planter to allow a walk-through point.
- Grass re-seeding has occurred.

C. Review of New Bids

- Landscaping at 1847-1848 Ashmeade due to gas line repairs was approved by the Board and will commence the week of March 21.
- Other work approved by the board and committee includes landscape repairs/upgrades on Ashmeade, Foxhall, Huxley and Greenwich.

D. Long Term Planning

- The committee will continue to look for areas where plants have died or are distressed and replace as needed.
- Medallion will be preparing a bid to mulch the complex in the spring (in compliance with SCVWD turf removal).
- Medallion will be preparing a bid to remove the kikuyu grass from the lawns along Leigh Avenue in the spring.
- The committee continues to monitor all landscaping. Any plants that die (from recent plantings) are replaced by Medallion (as long as the cause is not from pets).
