A. Walk About

B. Review of Recent New Work

- Work will continue this month to complete hard pruning. Due to wet weather, some plants that have been hard pruned have been subject to mildew and will be sprayed. They should recover with warm weather.
- Medallion will re-seed around new maple near Clubhouse and also an area on Foxhall that did not seed fully
- Landscaping at 1847-1848 Ashmeade due to gas line repairs was completed
- Other upgrades were completed on Greenwich and Huxley

C. Review of New Bids

• Reviewed bids for upgrades on Ashmeade at Hamilton Place entrance. Medallion will resubmit one bid at reduced cost. Committee will be forwarding these to Board for approval at their June meeting.

D. Long Term Planning

- The committee has requested bids for areas where plants have died or are distressed and will prioritize for approval as funds are available
- Medallion will submit a bid to remove the kikuyu grass from the lawns along Leigh Avenue for Board approval at the June meeting
- The committee continues to monitor all landscaping. Any plants that die (from recent plantings) are replaced by Medallion (as long as the cause is not from pets).
