II. Call to Order

Co-Chair Maryalice Heim convened the meeting to review ongoing and needed work at 7:05 p.m.

III. Ongoing Work

Review of Maintenance Concerns and Recent New Work

- During these Fall months, Medallion's focus will be on cleaning up leaves throughout the complex.
- Kikuyu Grass areas on Greenwich and Huxley will be reseeded the week of October 22.
- Medallion will remove the fireblight-infected branches on all Pear Trees during the fall/winter pruning. We can expect this to be done once the leaf clean-up is completed.

Irrigation

- Medallion confirmed that they have an irrigation technician on site once a week. The technician does not change clock settings if this is needed, Medallion's supervisor for our complex makes these changes.
- Medallion completed irrigation repairs under the Redwoods on the island due to roots; a main valve repair; and repair of two broken lateral lines on Donovan and Greenwich.
- Board-approved bid to repair, replace and add irrigation components to selected areas is scheduled for completion.

Review of Bids

- Committee-approved bids include covering below-ground level drains with rocks to prevent clogged drains; replacement of plants in various locations that have died.
- Previous committee-approved work was reviewed for completion. Committee will need to verify final completion.

Long Term Planning

• Committee is developing recommendations for the next calendar year that will identify areas for landscape improvements, mature hedge replacements and turf removal.

Trees

• Medallion has completed a revised tree replacement map that Nathan Lewis will submit to the City of San Jose for permit approval.
