III. Ongoing Work

Review of Maintenance Concerns and Recent New Work

- Medallion will continue to focus on weed control, trimming / tipping back plants (e.g., ferns, carex grasses, lorapetalums and westringias), snail baiting, and fertilizing camellias and other struggling plants (to see if this will reverse their decline).
- Medallion will complete the second round of reseeding grass areas in June

Irrigation

• Medallion will continue to monitor and repair irrigation as required

Review of Bids

- The committee approved 13 bids throughout the complex
- The committee reviewed scope of work approved by the Board at the recent meeting (5 bids). Kikuyu grass project (one of the 5 bids) will commence in late August.
- Medallion will replace plants that are under warranty by the first week in July

Long Term Planning

• Committee is planning recommendations for the Board for 2014 to encompass mature hedge removals and small turf removals

Trees

• Lewis Tree will begin their assessment for 2013 tree trimming and removals on July 24th to include the two Hackberry Trees by the main pool (due to sidewalk damage from their roots). From the assessment, Lewis will submit a plan for the Board's approval.
