### II. Ongoing Work

### **Review of Maintenance Concerns and Recent New Work**

- Medallions focus is cleaning landscaped areas in preparation for the annual mulching
- Medallion has completed their tree trimming with the exception of a few Pear trees which will be completed by the end of this month
- Medallion has completed trimming frost-damaged plants and will continue to hard prune hedges as needed
- Medallion has completed the large debris clean up under the Redwood trees.

## **Irrigation**

- Medallion will submit a bid for the broken irrigation lines on Greenwich behind the fence along the creek trail
- Medallion has set the watering schedule for the complex at two 2 times per week
- Medallion will continue to monitor and repair irrigation as necessary

### **Review of Bids**

- Reviewed approved Board bids and four approved Committee bids for improvements throughout the complex
- Medallion has started the landscaping project on Greenwich by the gas leak area

#### **Long Term Planning**

• The committee will review landscape bids for long-term turf and hedge removals with Medallion

#### **Trees**

- The City of San Jose has approved the Eucalyptus tree at the Greenwich entrance for removal. Lewis Tree Service has scheduled the removal for March 26<sup>th</sup> and Medallion will follow through with a landscape proposal for this area.
- Lewis Tree Service will file for a permit in March to remove the two Pear trees on Ashmead, that are causing damage to the building, per the Board's request.
