Review of Maintenance Concerns and Recent New Work

- Medallion will focus on leaf debris clean up throughout the complex
- Medallion will continue to rake and clean up debris from plants under all the Redwood Trees
- Winter maintenance will include the annual pruning of the Crepe Myrtle and Pear trees and hard pruning large shrubs to keep them size appropriate for the landscape beds

III. Irrigation

- Medallion is currently monitoring manual and automatic controls for the Winter transition
- Medallion will continue to monitor and repair irrigation as necessary

IV. Review of Bids

• Committee reviewed bids for work to be completed during the first quarter of 2015. These will be approved and forwarded to Medallion for scheduling.

V. Long-Term Planning

• Committee has submitted a long term (four year) composite plan for landscape renovation to include turf and large hedge removals to begin in 2015. The committee will submit recommended areas to be completed in 2015 for Board approval.

VI. Trees

- Lewis Tree Service will file for a landscape adjustment permit to remove the four declining Sycamore trees on Greenwich on Friday Nov 21 and will include the Board's cover letter with their application and documentation
- Lewis Tree Service will start the 2014 tree trimming project on Dec 8 and should be completed by the end of the month.
