- Medallion is doing winter trimming on the Hydrangeas, Roses and Nandinas.

III. Irrigation

• Medallion has shut off irrigation for the winter.

IV. Review of Bids

- Committee approved bids for planting throughout the complex in February.
- Committee reviewed bids for Board approval to remove turf and re-landscape areas with drought-tolerant landscaping and converting irrigation in those areas to high efficiency sprinklers.

V. Long-Term Planning

• Committee is working with Medallion to plan for long-range water conservation methods and drought-tolerant landscaping.

VI. Trees

- Lewis Tree Service removed one dead Alder tree and two dead Plum trees on Greenwich and two dead Plum trees on Ashmead.
- Replacement trees were planted for the 5 tree removals as required by the City of San Jose.
- Medallion's fall tree trimming of crape myrtles and evergreen pears has been completed.
- Medallion will submit a bid to reseed lawn in areas where trees were removed (when replacements were put in different locations).
