- Lawn fertilization has been completed.

IV. Review of Bids

- Committee reviewed the complex mulch bid to be submitted to the Board for approval at the May meeting.
- Committee approved bids for work to commence in April throughout the complex. These include replacement of plants that have died or are declining, stabilizer treatment for tan fines paths, and improvements in irrigation to include high efficiency sprinklers.

- Medallion will treat Hackberry trees for aphids to help reduce sap and will be completed end of April.
