Ongoing Work

Review of Maintenance Concerns and Recent New Work

• Medallion's focus will be on Fall debris clean up and opening up hedges.

Irrigation

Medallion continues to adjust irrigation as needed with focus on water conservation.

Review of Rids

• Medallion will submit landscape bids in October for Committee's review.

Long-Term Planning

- Committee will be working with Medallion on a new long-term landscape plans to target areas for water conservation methods (such as high efficiency sprinklers), turf removal and drought-tolerant landscaping.
- Committee will be identifying shrubs for hard pruning in the winter.

Trees

- Board approved Lewis Tree Service bid for 2016 tree trimming and removal of 9 diseased trees. Work will begin the week of November 7.
- Medallion will submit a tree replacement map for the 9 trees to be removed and Committee will forward to Lewis to include with the permit approval request for the City of San Jose.
- Medallion will also provide bid for replacement trees noted above this will occur <u>after</u> the permit is received from the City of San Jose.
- Committee will schedule a walk through with Lewis to identify trees to be deep-watered and fertilized for Board-approved bid; A list of future trees to be deep-watered and fertilized will also be identified at this time.
- Committee will ask Lewis to check two declining Sycamore trees near the Greenwich entrance on Hamilton Place.
