Ongoing Work

Review of Maintenance Concerns and Recent New Work

- Medallion's focus will be winter storm debris clean up and hard pruning pittisporum, xylosma, abelia, photinia and other hedges.
- Committee will identify shrubs to be hard pruned during the winter months.

Irrigation

Medallion has turned off the irrigation for the winter months during the rainy season.

Review of Bids

- Reviewed list of approved bids for work to be completed in February.
- Committee and Medallion also reviewed list of requested bids to be submitted in February.

Long-Term Planning

- Committee has identified areas for turf and hedge removals and will prioritize work for completion in a multi-year plan. This plan, focusing on water conservation, will include replacing turf with drought-tolerant landscaping and use of high efficiency sprinklers.
- Medallion will submit bids for areas in the above plan identified to be completed in 2017.

Trees

- Lewis Tree Service completed 2016 annual tree trimming in December.
- Lewis Tree Service removed 9 trees in December that were approved by the City of San Jose.
- Medallion completed planting replacement trees for above removals in January.
