## **Ongoing Work**

### **Review of Maintenance Concerns and Recent New Work**

• Medallion will continue to focus on hard pruning hedges, including the pittosporum, xylosma, abelia and photinia, based on committee recommendations.

### **Irrigation**

- The irrigation clocks were turned off during the winter months; but will be turned back on as warm weather returns. The frequency and duration of irrigation will be closely monitored.
- An irrigation system check will be completed in March.

### **Review of Bids**

- Committee is waiting to receive all requested bids from Medallion before submitting 2017 plan to the Board.
- Committee's plan, to be submitted for Board approval, will prioritize bids that focus on water conservation as well as area upgrades that incorporate drought tolerant, size-appropriate plantings.

## **Long-Term Planning**

- Committee has identified areas for turf and hedge removals and will prioritize work for completion in a multi-year plan. This plan, focusing on water conservation, will include replacing turf with drought-tolerant landscaping and use of high efficiency sprinklers, as appropriate.
- Medallion will continue to submit bids for areas in the above plan identified to be completed in 2017, as budget allows.

#### Trees

- Lewis Tree Service will schedule removal of diseased Sycamore Tree on Ashmeade in March.
- Medallion will plant a Crepe Myrtle Tree on Greenwich to replace the removed tree on Ashmeade.
- Medallion has completed spraying all the Plum Trees to reduce fruit production.
