Ongoing Work: Review of Maintenance Concerns and Recent New Work

• Medallion continues to focus on Fall leaf clean up, trimming, landscape detail, and weed control.

Irrigation: The frequency and duration of irrigation continues to be closely monitored and adjustments are made as needed for changes in the weather or to accommodate new plantings.

- Medallion addresses irrigation issues as they arise.
- Irrigation is currently shut off; Medallion will adjust irrigation duration and frequency as weather changes.
- The Board and committee appreciate resident diligence in curbing personal water usage as well as any heads-up in detecting water leaks.

Review of New projects and Recently Approved Work

- Warranty replacements with Sarcococca at backflow will be completed in December.
- Medallion will submit 2022 landscape improvement bids prior to January Board Meeting.

Long-Term Planning: The Board focus for landscape improvement is to conserve water and install size-appropriate landscaping to reduce maintenance (trimming) requirements.

• Long-term plan includes areas for water conservation, capping sprinklers, installing mulch or rock; and replacing turf with drought-tolerant, size-appropriate landscaping, using high efficiency sprinklers, as needed.

Trees

- Lewis Tree Service has begun 2021 tree trimming and will be completed prior to year end.
- Lewis Tree Service has submitted tree removal permits to San Jose City.
