HOA BIZ - What's Happening around Hamilton Place

- Street Repairs and Sealing The repairs to the Association streets is now scheduled for the Spring once the warmer weather returns.
- **Board of Directors** Nicole Marie has been selected by the Board to fill the vacant Vice-President position.
- **Gutter Cleaning** Four Seasons Roofing has completed the initial cleaning of the roofs, gutters and downspouts. The cleaning carries a "no clog" warranty until May 1, 2012. If you see that your downspout has become clogged after the initial cleaning, please contact CMS Customer Service at 559-1977 to provide the clog location.
- Exterior Changes to Your Unit The HOA governing documents require that all changes to the exterior appearance of your unit must have prior approval from the Board of Directors. This means that anytime you want to change the exterior appearance of your unit, you must first provide a written request for approval to the Board describing, in detail, the proposed changes. Failure to do so may result in the Board requiring that you change the modification, at your expense. Check the HOA website.
- Architecture Violations Violation letters will be sent out in January for window coverings, satellite dishes and bright brass lights/door hardware.

Landscape Committee Report

The Board of Directors provides a budget to the Committee and determines the guidelines that the Committee must adhere to in planning for landscaping maintenance and upgrade projects.

Two major projects have recently been completed, including the removal of mature hedges in 18 locations around the Hamilton Place loop that are most visible. They have been replaced by a variety of low-irrigation plantings that will not require as much annual maintenance work. The second project was the removal of five dead trees and their replacements. This tree work completes the scheduled portion of the 2011 tree maintenance plan that has been established with Lewis Tree Service.

The Committee continues to monitor the landscaping throughout the community, looking for areas needing immediate attention as well as prioritizing future project areas when the budget allows. Areas scheduled for work in the near future include the entrance off of Leigh Avenue and further hedge replacements in the most visible areas.



2012 Monthly HOA Assessments

All homeowners were mailed a copy of the 2012 Approved Budget in November. As stated by Treasurer Carl Middione in last month's Newsletter, the Board's objective was to keep monthly assessments as near to flat as possible. The assess-

The sales pitch is to purchase "water line insurance protection". Please be aware that the HOA is responsible for all exterior utilities, including water, gas, electric and sewers. The expense of any such repairs is borne by the HOA and is included in the HOA budget. Hence, it is included in the monthly assessment paid by all owners.
