Keep These Out of Your Recycling



WHAT NOT TO RECYCLE



Plastic bags, wrap, film, and snack wrappers



Textiles, bedding, clothing, pillows, cushions, and shoes



Foods, liquid, and food-soiled packaging



Garden hoses, cords, hangers, and wires



Diapers and pet waste
